Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC)

On November 16, 2020, Dr. Mona Davies co-founder of Community Outreach Ministry a 501 C3 non-profit in Wildomar has been appointed for two years to the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC) by Supervisor Kevin Jeffries First District Board of Supervisors Riverside County to serve as the First District representative. In this capacity, Davies and Community Outreach Ministry will serve as a community-based organizations (CBOs) along with other CBOs from across the county with representatives from the following entities: District Attorney's office, Public Defender's office, Sheriff's department, Board of Supervisors, Social Services, Mental/Behavioral Health, City Police department, County Office of education or a school district, at-large community representative, and nonprofit CBOs providing services to minors. The JJCC develops a comprehensive multi-agency plan that identifies resources and strategies for providing an effective continuum of responses for the prevention, intervention, supervision, treatment, and incarceration of juvenile offenders, including strategies to develop and implement local out-of-home-placement options for the offender. The JJCC is chaired by the Chief Probation Officer Ronald L. Miller and meets several times per year to review/assess the outcomes of programs funded to support youth and families within the community.

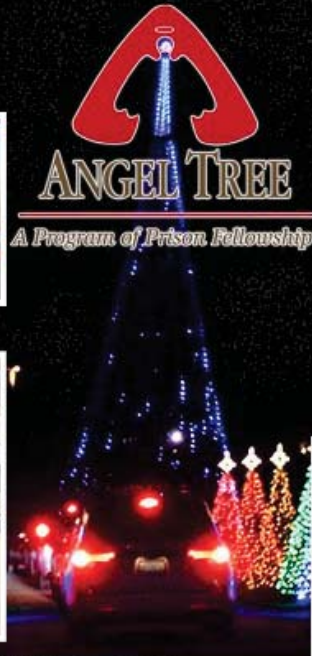
